Conrad Levy is a principal and founder of Elsworthy Associates, possessing a wealth of experience in auditing, consulting and operations. Prior to Elsworthy, Conrad was the Executive Manager for Global Banking & Finance at KPMG, after which he served as an independent Financial Services Consultant and a Hedge Fund Chief Operating Officer (“COO”) for multiple investment managers and a stint at Global Relay a pioneering AI-enabled company with 20+ years in messaging and regulatory compliance archiving. Conrad’s responsibilities encompassed all aspects of the investment management business, including HR, IT, Operations, Accounting Legal, Commercial, Fund Accounting, Investor Services, and fund structuring.

As a COO, Conrad ran the UK offices and managed the relationship with managers globally on their platforms, held Board positions on operational, investment management and fund entities in the UK, Europe, Hong Kong, and Singapore. Provided centralised oversight of the various managers and established a set of operational and compliance standards, including for one of Europe’s largest Hedge Fund Groups (Brummer & Partners). Conrad was heavily involved in helping investment managers institutionalise and negotiate with key counterparts (Prime Brokers, Administrators, lawyers, compliance advisors etc.). He was also a member of AIMA’s research committee for many years.

As an Independent Financial Consultant working with Reuteurs, Beauchamp Financial Technology (now Line Data), PwC and others. Whilst working with PwC Conrad uncovered the fraud at Weaving Capital after being brought in to provide advice to Weaving’s COO. Conrad subsequently served as an expert witness in the UK Civil and Criminal Trials against Weaving’s CEO and the Cayman Trial against the Fund Directors.

Prior to his time as a Financial Consultant and COO Conrad had 9 years’ experience working with KPMG in London where he was employed as an auditor and consultant in their Financial Services Practice from 1991 to 1999. Conrad also launched a specialist broadcaster of music events via the Internet in 2000 which broadcasted approximately one hundred artists and events including Fatboy Slim, Blur, The NME Awards, The Big Chill Festival and The Notting Hill Carnival.

Conrad is a Fellow of the Institute of Chartered Accountants England and Wales. He has a Bachelor and Masters (MA Cantab) in Law from Cambridge University.
